

TEAMWORK & SAFETY AWARD

Activity: “Sale Safety Den Meeting”

These activities are fun for Scouts and they’ll learn important reminders that will help them sell popcorn safely and effectively. It is a combination of songs, memorization and role playing.

Leader: Begin with the Pledge of Allegiance, then get the boys in the mood by singing the following son (to the tune of “Row, Row, Row Your Boat”).

Pop, pop, pop the corn,
Sizzling in hot oil.
Watch it burst, sprinkle the salt,
And get the movie out!

(Repeat three or four times, louder, louder, softer...or sing as a “round”).

Follow the song with a popcorn game. Then discuss the Trail’s End Safety Rules:

- ❖ ALWAYS sell with a buddy.
- ❖ Only ONE person should approach the door.
- ❖ Do NOT carry large amounts of cash.
- ❖ NEVER enter anyone’s home, even if you know them.
- ❖ ALWAYS walk on the sidewalk and driveway, not through the yard.
- ❖ ALWAYS watch for traffic.
- ❖ ALWAYS act like a Scout, and be polite and courteous.
- ❖ ALWAYS wear your uniform.
- ❖ Make a COPY of your take-order form before you turn it in to your Den leader.
